Welcome

Thank you for selecting Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria for your funeral needs. Purchasing a cemetery product, either in preparation for the future or for the loss of a loved one can be a distressing time for both you and your family.

It's all about peace of mind

This Product Disclosure Statement is designed to provide in detail information about the cemetery products you are purchasing, to help you decide if it's what you need.

This document along with the Sales Agreement you will complete if you decided to proceed with your purchase will outline the terms and conditions of the purchase. You may find that only parts of this document are relevant to your purchase.

We may need to update this PDS from time to time. We'll do this if certain changes occur e.g. legislative or policy changes. An up to date copy of the PDS will always be made available to you on request from our office.

At the end of this document is a list of all products and services offered for sale by Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria outlining the purchase inclusions, the monument types applicable to the product purchased and associated costs that may be incurred in addition to the purchase price. You should carefully read this document in its entirety before making a purchase decision.

Cemetery Legislation and Regulation

The Cemeteries and Crematoria Act 2013 (the C&C Act) sets out the interment rights system for New South Wales. The C&C Act applies to all cemeteries in NSW, ensuring a consistent and transparent system throughout the state.

Cemeteries & Crematoria NSW (CCNSW) is the government statutory agency responsible for regulatory oversight of the interment rights system, seeking to educate and assist both consumers and industry.

Who are We?

Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria is an independent not-for-profit organisation and one of the largest cemetery trusts in NSW.

Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria manage two types of cemeteries:

Catholic Cemeteries

- Rookwood Catholic Cemetery & Western Sydney Crematoria
- North Rocks Catholic Cemetery

Multi Denominational / General Cemeteries

- Kemps Creek Memorial Park
- Liverpool Cemetery
- Macarthur Memorial Park (Under development)

Choosing a Catholic Cemetery

When we are baptised, we are brought to a sacred place, a Catholic church, and baptised into the mystery of Christ's death and resurrection - thus giving us the promise of eternal life. When one of our loved ones die, we take them to another sacred place, a Catholic cemetery, for burial in sacred ground while they await resurrection and the promise of eternal life.

Who can Officiate a funeral service in a Catholic Cemetery?

Unlike other burial grounds or cemeteries, Catholic Cemeteries are consecrated and constitute a "sacred space" which the church designates and reserves exclusively for the worship of God. Once consecrated a building or area may not be used again for a secular purpose unless under extraordinary circumstances with approval from the Archdiocese.

Therefore, only Catholic Clergy, ordained ministers of recognised Religions and Liturgically (Catholic) trained Funeral Ministers can officiate in chapels and onsite at Rookwood and North Rocks Catholic Cemeteries.

Can a non-Catholic be buried in a Catholic Cemetery?

Yes. It is permissible for non-Catholic to be buried in a Catholic Cemetery. (Applicable at Rookwood Catholic and North Rocks Cemeteries Only).

Catholics and Cremation

Since 1963, Catholics have been allowed to choose cremation over burial as a means of laying a loved one to rest. Cremation is a popular choice since it is less expensive and more manageable than a full burial.

Guidelines from the Vatican's doctrinal office released in 2016, provide instruction in relation to burying the deceased and conserving the dignity of cremated remains when cremation is chosen.

Out of respect for the integrity and sacredness of both body and cremated remains, the guidelines expressly forbid Catholics from scattering cremated remains and encourage cremated remains to be kept in a "sacred place" such as a church or cemetery. Cremated Remains should not be divided up between family members, "nor may they be preserved in mementos, pieces of jewellery or other objects."

In accordance with the Vatican guidelines, Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria do not allow the scattering of ashes at our Catholic cemeteries nor do we offer the ability to divide ashes.



Cemetery Products and Services

Interment Right Products

An interment right is a contract between the cemetery and the right holder permitting the right holder to have human remains buried in a particular location within the cemetery.

It is important to note that the purchase of an interment right does not constitute ownership of the land.

When it comes to purchasing an interment right product there are three main choices:

Above Ground Burials

For above ground burial, families can choose a family vault or crypt within our landscaped grounds at Rookwood.

The difference between a crypt and a vault is that a vault is a large free-standing building to be shared by family members and contains various shelf configurations. A crypt can be purchased as a single or double and are housed within a building with other crypts.

Below Ground Burials

Below ground burials vary depending on the headstone.

A *lawn grave* is generally a simple headstone usually crafted from granite or marble. This sits above ground at the head of the grave usually on a concrete beam and the area where the coffin is buried is covered by turf.

For something more decorative, a *monumental lawn grave* allows for a more personalised tribute to be erected on concrete beam base. This sits above ground at the head of the grave usually on a concrete beam and the area where the coffin is buried is covered by turf.


A traditional *monumental section grave* allows for the grave to be fully covered by a stone monument, usually crafted from granite or marble by a stonemason. The monument sits above ground on top of the grave.

Please note that coffin size restrictions apply to monumental section grave areas (a maximum of 23" in width) allowing for the area required for the building of a monument – our staff will be happy to assist you further.



Cremated Remains Memorials

Cremated remains can be interred within an arrangement of a series of special indoor alcoves (columbarium), a bank along an outdoor niche wall or cemetery garden used for the interment of cremated human remains.



Types of Services

Cremation & Chapel Services

We provide a full range of cremation services at our Rookwood cemetery including:

- A full cremation service including a chapel service.
- No Service No Attendance cremation no chapel is required and the remains of your loved one will be prepared ready for collection or interment into an appropriate location.

We also have a variety of chapels designed to farewell your loved one according to your budget, or specific requirements.

Interment Fees

Interment fees (also known as Opening and Closing fees) can include 50 or more separate services provided by the cemetery and are payable each time a grave, crypt, vault or niche is used to inter human remains unless expressly included in a product package.

Typically, a below ground interment fee includes:

 administration and permanent record keeping (determining ownership, obtaining permission and the completion of other documentation which may be required, entering the interment particulars in the interment register and maintaining all legal files).

- opening and closing the grave or crypt (locating the grave and laying out the boundaries, excavating and filling the interment space).
- installation and removal of the lowering device or lifting device / or scaffolding.
- placement and removal of artificial grass dressing and equipment at the grave site.
- levelling, tamping, re-grading and turfing the grave site and levelling and re-turfing the grave over a period of time as the earth settles.
- Labour costs and ongoing cemetery maintenance funding.
- ♦ GST and Government Levies.

Ancillary Services

Ancillary services include services or items that may be purchased in addition to a burial product, for example:

- Monuments including inscriptions, photos, vases, permit fees etc.
- Administrative fees such as transfer fees, clergy payments, late fees etc.

Interment Rights in General

When I buy an Interment Right am I buying the land?

No. It is important to understand that the location in which we bury (Inter) always remains in the possession and control of Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria.

You will be purchasing the legal 'right' to bury in a location prepared by us for this purpose.

How long does an Interment Right last for?

All interment rights sold within our two Catholic Cemeteries are Perpetual Interment Rights.

A perpetual interment right gives you the peace of mind to bury human remains in a particular grave within the cemetery and for those remains to be left undisturbed forever (in perpetuity).

The type of interment right will always be clearly shown on the certificate of ownership once your application is accepted by us.

How many people can own an Interment Right?

An interment right can be held equally by two or more joint holders. When one joint holder dies, the remaining right holder/s becomes the holder/s of the right.

It is important to consider who is listed as a holder – these are the people who will be able to give permission for a person(s) to be interred within the location and any decisions relating to erecting a monument and providing an inscription for the site.

What is an Interment Right Certificate?

An interment right certificate shows you:

- Full Name(s) of the interment right holder/s.
- Details of the site which the interment right relates to.
- Identify if the interment right is granted as a perpetual right or as a renewable right.
- Specify the number of persons whose remains may be interred in the site.

- Identify the person or class of persons whose remains may be interred in the site.
- Specify that the interment right may be transferred.

As this is a legal document please keep this certificate in a safe place, so you can refer to this in the future.

What information do I need to provide to purchase an Interment Right?

You need to give us certain information for us to process an application to purchase an interment right, this information is prescribed by the Cemeteries and Crematoria Act NSW 2013.

The information you will be required to give are:

- The names and contact details of the intended holder/s of interment right/s.
- The names and contact details for your next of kin.
- Specify the interment site (we will help you to decide).
- The grave type this might be a monumental lawn, general lawn grave or columbarium.
- The identity of who may be interred.
- Specify the name of a person who can nominate who will be buried (generally this will be the owner/s).

All listed applicants must produce two original identification documents, one of which must provide photo identification. These may include a passport, license issued under Australian law (driver's licence or other government-issued licence), birth certificate/citizenship certificate, credit card, EFTPOS card, Medicare card, or membership to a registered club.

We will confirm with you the following information:

- The maximum number of people able to be interred at this location either as full body or cremated remains burials.
- A breakdown of fees and charges related to the interment right and subsequent burials.

What is an Interment Right holder's rights and responsibilities?

When you purchase an interment right you have the following rights and responsibilities:

- The automatic right to be interred in the interment site.
- The right to direct us to who may or may not be interred in the interment site.
- The right to decide if a monument, plaque or inscription will be erected at the site.
- The right to object to or endorse an application to exhume (remove) human remains from the site.
- The right to transfer or bequeath an interment right to another party.
- It is your obligation to maintain and or repair any monument or masonry structure i.e. Vault, headstone and monument (apart from a cemetery lawn grave in which we maintain on your behalf).

Transfer or bequest of an Interment Right

Interment rights can be transferred to another person. Only the holder can apply for the transfer. If the interment right is held by joint holders, the application must be made and signed by all right holders.

You will be able to transfer an interment right once an appropriate transfer application and fee has been received by the cemetery. However, we may refuse a transfer if the person to be listed already holds the legally allowed maximum of 2 interment rights already. This is prohibited by law as a transfer of this type could encourage additional dealing in interment rights.

You may also bequeath your right as part of your estate within your will at the time of your death.

An application will need to be made to our office to enable the cemetery register to be updated accordingly. If there are two or more joint holders of an interment right, upon the death of one holder, the remaining holder or holders are entitled to the right.

Our friendly Client services team will assist you with any questions you may have. A fee will be payable for all ownership transfers (please see our pricing list).

Cemetery Repurchase of Interment Rights

An interment right holder may wish to sell their Interment Right back to the Cemetery. Interment rights can only be sold back to the Cemetery in accordance with the Cemeteries and Crematoria Act 2013 No. 105.

We may repurchase an unused interment right at our discretion. Each repurchase request will be assessed individually and will be dependent upon the location, accessibility and state of the site.

The cemetery will **not** repurchase interment rights:

- If an interment has taken place at the site.
- If a monument, headstone, inscription or other structure has been erected on the site (excluding lawn grave headstones purchased as part of the Interment Right).
- If ownership of the interment right is subject to a dispute.

The repurchase price will be calculated at 50% of current value or original purchase price whichever is greater, less 10% for maintenance and administrative costs incurred by the cemetery.

Private Sale of Interment Rights

On occasion an interment right holder may wish to transfer the ownership to another person, the process for transferring is outlined above.

It is important to note that cemetery products that are sold as 'packages' and contain future services provisions such as prepaid interment fees, prepaid cremation fees etc cannot be transferred to another party and can only be sold back to the cemetery under the repurchase process outlined above.

Revocation of Interment Rights

A perpetual interment right must be used within 50 years of purchase. If it is not used, the cemetery can revoke the right in accordance with the Cemetery and Crematoria Act NSW No 105. Before revoking a perpetual interment right, the cemetery must take reasonable steps to contact the holder of the interment right.

Monuments, Headstones and Structures

Some products such as Monumental Lawn and Monumental Sections Graves do not include any form of headstone, allowing you to design and source a memorial that is suitable for your needs with a suitably qualified and registered Monumental Mason.

A memorial permit is required for all monument installations prior to any work beginning in the cemetery. We strongly encourage you to ask your mason to apply for and receive an approved memorial permit from the cemetery before making payment for any memorial, monument, or marker.

Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria does not endorse or recommend any one specific Stone Mason. We have an extensive list of Stone Masons available that meet the requirements to work in Catholic Cemeteries available on request.

Headstones and Structures

Headstones and structures must be designed and constructed according to sound engineering principles to provide a stable monument that is durable, serviceable and which provides satisfactory performance for the life of the monument.

While construction of memorials is strictly controlled to ensure with compliance with Australian Standar AS4020-1994, there is also various height restrictions in place as per below.

Monumental Lawn Grave: 1200mmheight with allowance for additional 300mm cross on top if required.

Monumental Section Grave: 1500mm height with allowance of 300mm cross on top if required.

The erection and installation of headstones or structures must be done by an appropriately qualified professional approved to work within the cemetery and monumental work must be in accordance with cemetery requirements and to Australian Standard AS 4204-2019 Headstones and Cemetery Monuments and AS 4425 – 1996 Above ground burial structures.

Who owns and is responsible for the structure?

Any structure erected on the grave is the property of and responsibility of the interment right holder/s.

The holder(s) and the holder's legal successors are responsible for the structure including but not limited to the ongoing maintenance and upkeep of any structure erected at the interment site.

Injury to Person or Property by the Structure

The holder/s acknowledges that they are liable for any injury caused to any person or property by the collapse of any structure they have erected.

Power of the Cemetery to Move or Remove the Structure

Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria have the power to alter, move or remove the structures in any of the following circumstances:

- where the Cemetery have received the written consent of the holder or the holder's successors;
- where the Cemetery have been granted the power under a statutory enactment;
- where the structure has become dangerous to person or property and is beyond repair;
- where the structure was erected without a permit having been granted; or
- where the structure is not in accordance with the plans submitted prior to its approval for its erection being granted.

Additional Terms and Conditions relating to building Vaults

Site

A standard size family vault site is 4 metres x 4 metres in plain view and the maximum number of coffin spaces for that area shall be twelve (12). Requests for vault sites larger than standard to be considered on individual merits.

All building and ancillary work is to be wholly within the site size purchased i.e. 4 metres x 4 metres.

The maximum number of coffin spaces for larger areas shall be calculated at the rate of 1 coffin space for each 1.33 square metres of the site.

When purchasing a right of interment for a vault it is important to note that only one (1) Right of Interment is issued, no subdivision of site or Right of Interment is permitted.

Structure Approval

No structure can be erected without the approval of the Cemetery and where appropriate the local consent authority i.e. Council.

In considering an application for approval the Cemetery is to take into account the provisions of S.90 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act (in so far as that section is relevant) as if the application for approval was a development application.

Application to the Cemetery for approval shall be accompanied by plans prepared by an appropriately qualified professional e.g. Architect.

No building work can be carried out except by a Contractor approved by the Cemetery.

Design and Construction

In the design and construction of any works the holder must comply with any relevant standard issued by Standards Australia from time to time.

Dimensions of Structure

- Floor The floor of any structure should be at or near the immediate surrounding ground level.
- Internal The maximum height of the uppermost shelf level shall be 3 metres from floor level.
- Roof height Maximum height of the outer roof surface shall be 4 metres above floor level.
- Embellishments The maximum height of any structure or embellishment shall be 6 metres above floor level.

External Finishes

Materials specifically not permitted for external finishes to vault structures include: -

- timber;
- fibrous cement sheeting;
- fibrous plaster;
- or any other material having a life expectancy of less than 50 years and considered unsuitable by the Cemetery.

Bond

Before any building work commences the holder will need to lodge with the Cemetery a bond of such amount as the Cemetery may determine for the proper construction of the vault in accordance with the approved plans and specifications and within the time required by the Cemetery.



Frequently asked Questions

How many burials can occur in a cemetery burial plot?

A burial plot can generally accommodate two to three adult burials, one above the other. Some sites can only take two interments due to soil type and bedrock. At the time of purchase, we need to be made aware of how many interments you require/prefer.

Can cremated remains be placed in a burial site?

Interment rights apply to cremated remains placed in a burial site but not to scattered ashes. Confirm with us the terms of your interment right.

If I choose cremation, is the coffin cremated with the body in it?

Yes, the coffin and body are cremated together.

Who maintains the cemetery grounds and memorials?

Maintaining a well-presented cemetery is a partnership between the Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria and the community.

Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria is responsible for maintaining the overall cemetery grounds and facilities while the interment right holder is responsible for maintaining memorials.

What grounds maintenance does the cemetery do?

Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria has specialist landscaping, grounds and facilities maintenance teams that work across its locations.

Examples include:

- Lawn mowing: lawns are mowed on a regular rotational basis.
- Grave top-ups: this occurs at all cemeteries over time as the earth settles following the burial; it occurs faster after periods of moderate-heavy rain.

- Upkeep of gardens and water features: a team of gardeners looks after gardens, removing weeds and planting fresh flowers.
- Facilities maintenance: mausolea, public toilets and car parks are regularly maintained to ensure positive customer experience.

The cost of maintenance is included within your Interment right fee along with provisioning of all perpetual care needs.

Whilst we will take every care please be aware of any requirements for the placement of personal memorabilia and keepsakes at a grave location.

We cannot guarantee the security of these possessions as our cemetery has many visitors daily.

As a cemetery is a sacred place, please take a note of any flower and ornamentation policies for the area you have selected – we may remove any items that do not fall into the required guidelines.

These guidelines form a protection for all customers, appropriate care of the land and environmental considerations.

If I buy a product which includes a headstone or plaque, what do I do if the inscription fades?

Over many years, the weather can take its toll on a plaque and inscription. Often, a memorial can become rather dirty or lose its shine, and the inscription can fade becoming very difficult to read.

Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria offer a refurbishment service, please enquire with our client services team as to costs and timeframes for this service.

Cemetery Terminology/ Glossary

Some commonly used terms related to interment and the operation of cemeteries and crematoria are provided below:

Burial refers to placing a casket, coffin or container holding human remains into an earth grave (also known as interment).

Cemetery operator's register is the register kept by a cemetery operator that records interment rights granted, memorials erected, each interment carried out and each cremation carried out.

Coffin or Casket is a container to hold whole body remains

Columbarium is a structure with niches (small spaces) for the placement of urns or other approved containers used for cremated remains. A columbarium may be outdoors or inside of a building.

Crypt is an above ground space in a mausoleum or other building to hold human remains.

Epitaph means the words written in memory of a person who has died, particularly as an inscription on a headstone.

Funeral director refers to a person (other than the operators of a mortuary transport service), who in the conduct of their business, engages, for the purpose of burial, cremation or transport, in the collection, transport, storage, preparation or embalming of bodies, or engages in the conduct of exhumations.

Grave is the site in the cemetery where the coffin or casket containing the deceased will be or has been placed.

Holder of an interment right means the person recorded in the cemetery operator's register as the holder of the interment right in relation to a particular location at that cemetery.

Interment of human remains means:

- burial of human remains in the earth.
- placement of human remains in a mausoleum, vault, columbarium or other structure designed for that purpose.

Interment Fee means the fee payable to the cemetery for the purpose of facilitating the burial of human remains. Can also be known as Open and Closing Fee.

Interment right is a contract between a cemetery operator and a right holder permitting the right holder to have human remains buried in a particular location in a cemetery.

Interment site means a place in a cemetery for the interment of human remains.

Lawn Grave is a type of grave that costs of a small headstone or plaque on a beam. There is no kerbing around the grave, no pathways and no grave plantings. The area where the coffin is interred is covered in turf.

Mausoleum is a building in which human remains are interred (placed).

Memorial refers to a monument, plaque, headstone, garden or other item to be installed on a site to commemorate or identify.

Memorial garden is a rose or planted garden for placing cremated ashes.

Monumental Lawn is a type of grave that costs of a concrete beam on which a headstone can be installed. There is no kerbing around the grave, no pathways and no grave plantings. The area where the coffin is interred is covered in turf.

Monumental Mason is a provider of stonemasonry services including the creation, installation and repairs of headstones and other memorials.

Monumental Section Grave is a type of grave that allows for monumental stonework to be installed covering the entire grave space.

Niche is a space in a columbarium, mausoleum or garden to hold cremated remains.

Perpetual interment right allows human remains to be buried and left undisturbed forever.

Revocation is the cancellation or taking back of a perpetual interment right by a cemetery operator when an interment right has not been used within 50 years of purchase.

Urn is a container to hold cremated human remains. It can be placed in a columbarium or mausoleum, be buried in the ground, or retained by the family.

Vault is an above ground structure built for the purpose of housing multiple human remains.






